

ORDINANCE NO. 677

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RETAIL LIQUOR STORES AND LIQUOR-LICENSED DRUG STORES IN THE TOWN OF HAYDEN TO CONDUCT ON SITE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TASTINGS.

RECITALS

1. The Town Council of the Town of Hayden, Colorado, acting as the local liquor licensing authority, is empowered to grant, suspend, revoke and otherwise regulate liquor licenses within the Town; and
2. Pursuant to Section 12-47-301(10), C.R.S. provides that if a municipality so chooses, it may authorize alcoholic beverage tasting in accordance with the provisions outlined therein; and
3. The Town Council of the Town of Hayden desires to authorize limited alcohol tastings, as outlined in Section 12-47-301(10), C.R.S.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Hayden, Colorado:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 12-47-301(10)(a), C.R.S, the Town of Hayden hereby authorizes alcoholic beverage tastings of malt, vinous, or spirituous liquor for licensed retail liquor stores and liquor-licensed drug stores within the Town subject to the requirements and limitations contained in Section 12-47-301(10), C.R.S., as the same may be amended from time to time.

Section 2. Each license is restricted to a maximum of 104 tastings per year which may occur no more than four (4) of the six days from Monday through the following Saturday each week, and not to exceed four (4) hours in duration per day.

Section 3. All bylaws, orders, resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revise any bylaw, order, resolution or ordinance, or part thereof, theretofore repealed.


Section 4. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance; and the Town Council hereby

declares it would have passed this ordinance, and each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, regardless of the fact that any one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid.

Section 5. The Town Board hereby finds, determines and declares that this ordinance is necessary and proper for the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Hayden and the inhabitants thereof.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication as required by law.


